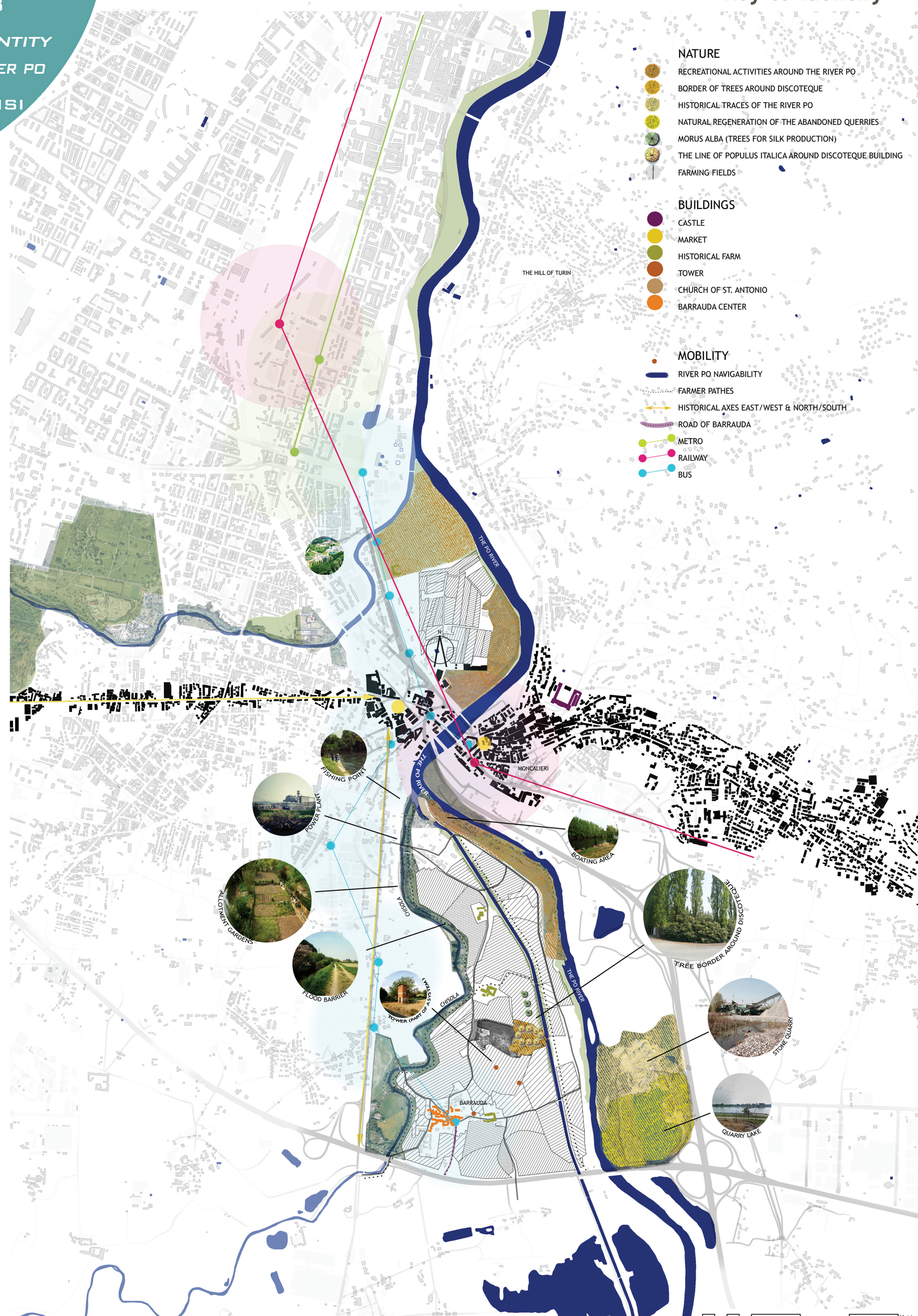
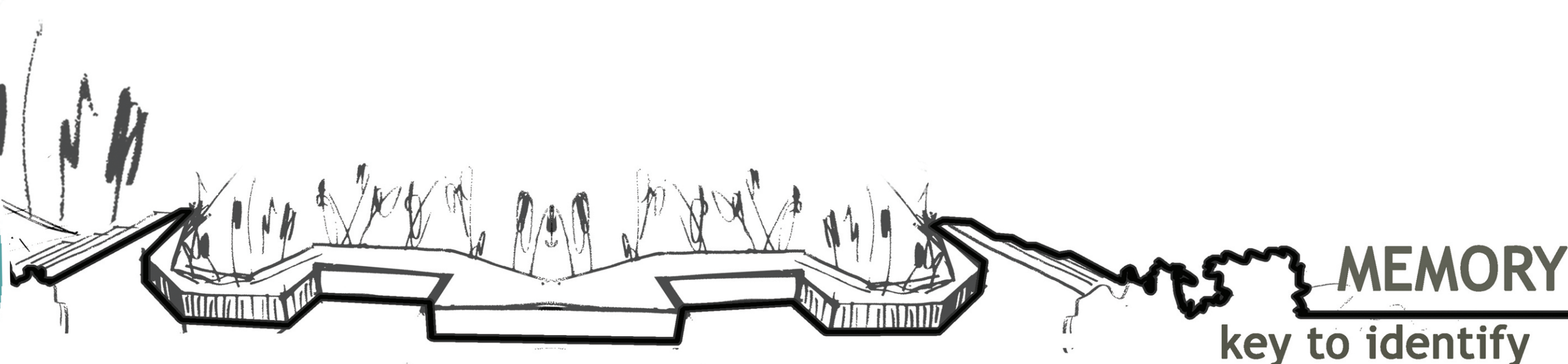

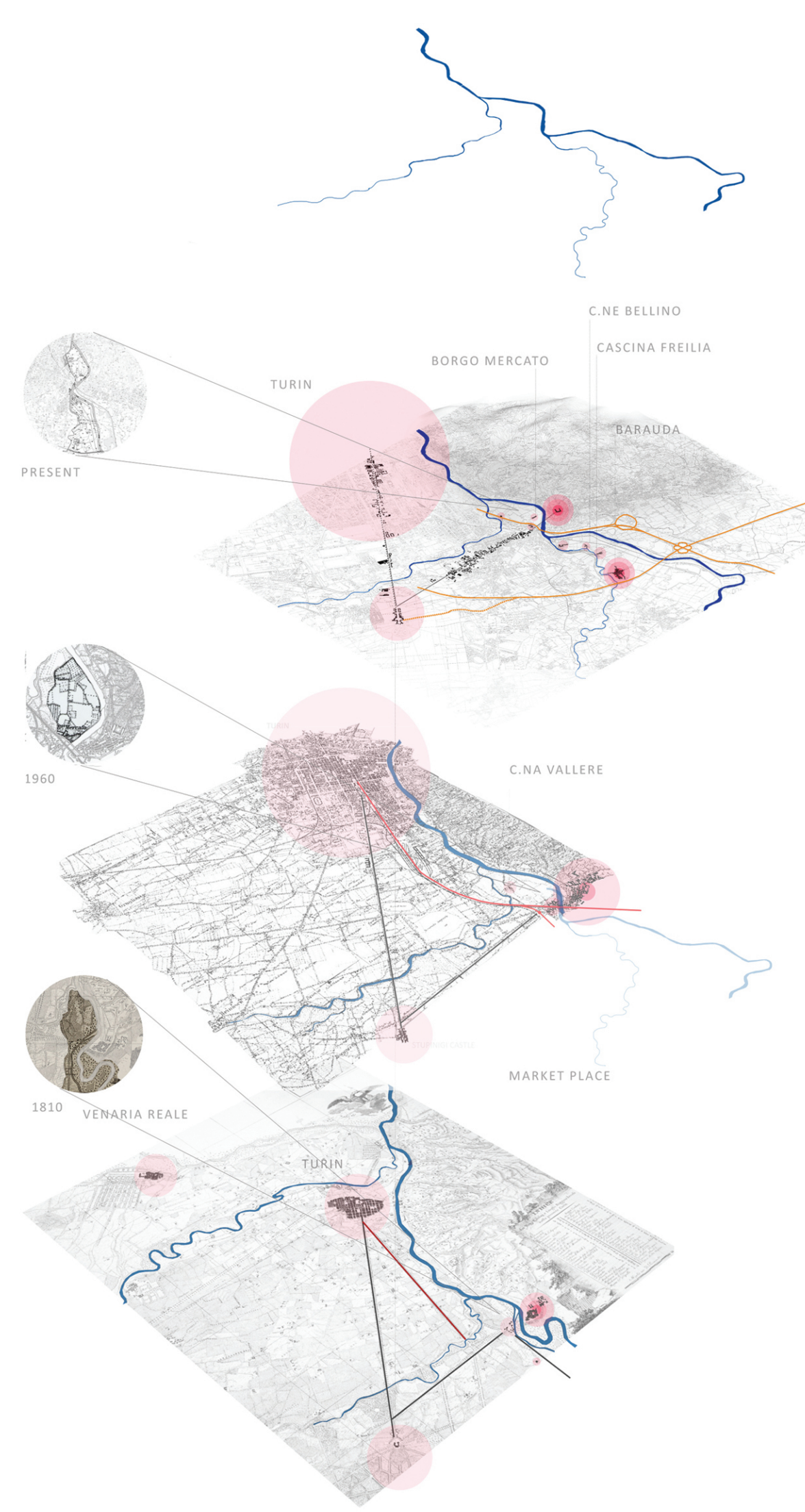

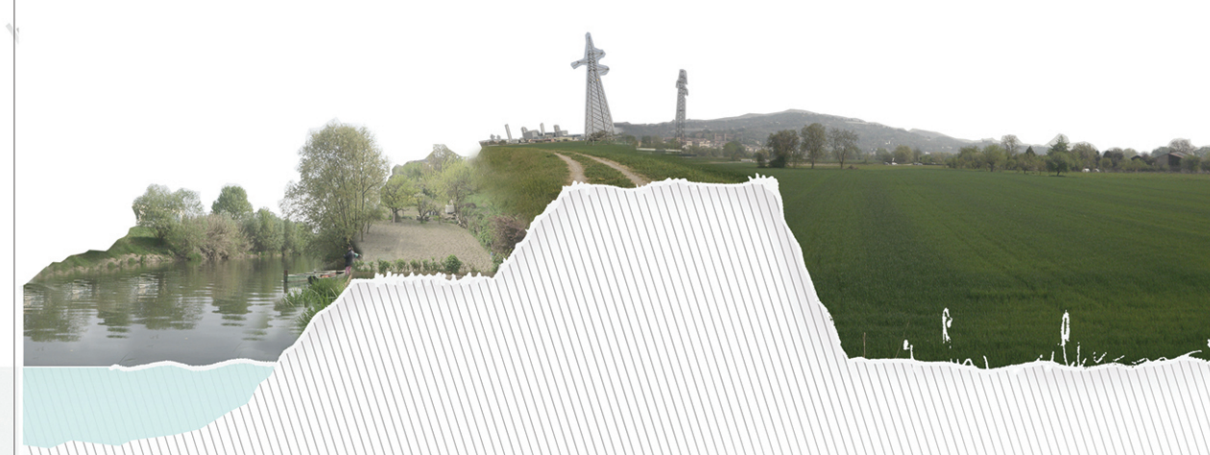
The Plain of Turin is located on the South-East of the city, within the borders of Moncalieri. This area is relatively flat and characterized by extensive human settlements and intensive farming in large plots of open field. The low forest coverage of the Plain contrasts with the adjacent luxuriant hills of Torino.

GENERAL OVERVIEW AND MOBILITY



This diagram shows the evolution of the Plain of Turin over the past two centuries. The comparison highlights Torino's and Moncalieri's expansion in a movement of urban sprawl and the transition between the traditional mobility systems in relation to the Savoy residences to new ways. These phenomenon's have had a huge impact in the current organization of fields and of the area, and so did agriculture modernization and globalization.
